# <u>Updates</u>

**Pesticides** – (David Thomas WG Pesticide Policy Team)

Policy "is to reduce pesticide use as much as possible in Wales" in consultation with CRD. Grandfather Rights will be removed by the end of 2015 with the following implemented:

- Training via City and Guilds and Lantra
- · Equipment testing
- Grassland and Forage Group will be set up
- Mobile App for farmers

#### Points raised:

- fertiliser applications are more of an issue for pollinators
- bracken is v important part of the environment i.e. mosaic habitats

# Cywain Project – (Jenny Shaw WBKA)

Project runs from November 2014 – May 2015 with 2 strands:

- Working in conjunction with Menter a Busnes offering advice and information to landowners and farmers in the form of a leaflet on honey production.
- Produced a video teaching aid for primary schools that is planned to go out across Wales.
